Wizz Air connects Hahn Airport with two new destinations

Bucharest and Sibiu: Two new routes will be added to the flight schedule at TRIWO Hahn Airport in the upcoming summer flight schedule. The flights will be operated by Wizz Air.

From August 1, 2025, the airline will connect Hahn Airport with the Romanian capital Bucharest. According to legend, the metropole was founded by the shepherd Bucur, whose name means "joy". Bucharest invites its visitors to explore the beautiful historic parts of the city, marvel at the triumphal arch or relax while strolling along the wide, tree-lined boulevards. Wizz Air operates the Hahn-Bucharest flights on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays.

From August 2, 2025, the airline will also connect Hahn Airport with Sibiu twice a week. Located in the geographical heart of Romania, Sibiu is a cultural city with impressive fortress walls and one of the largest theater festivals in Europe. Every Tuesday and Saturday, a plane takes off from Hahn and flies to the Romanian city. Sibiu was last represented in the 2022 summer flight schedule and the 2022/2023 winter flight schedule at TRIWO Hahn Airport.

From April 14, 2025, Wizz Air will also resume the Hahn-Varna route. The port city lying on the Black Sea was already part of last summer's flight schedule. The airline currently also connects Hahn Airport with Cluj-Napoca in Romania and Kutaisi in Georgia. Wizz Air also currently takes off from TRIWO Hahn Airport to the capital cities of Tirana (Albania), Skopje (North Macedonia) and Sofia (Bulgaria).
